3. Proof of ownership of the premises from where the tow truck is proposed to be operated.

Either of the following will be accepted:

- A copy of a rate notice in the name of the licence holder; or
- A copy of a leasing agreement between the licence holder and the owner of the premises; or
- A copy of a sub-leasing agreement between the licence holder and the lessee, together with written consent from the owner of the premises.
