Post Completion Evaluation of Great Ocean Road / Camp Road / Cameron Road Roundabout

Project Description

During peak periods, significant levels of congestion and delays are experienced at the Great Ocean Road / Camp Road / Cameron Road roundabout in the centre of Anglesea. In response to this issue, in 2016/2017 VicRoads upgraded the existing roundabout at Great Ocean Road / Camp Road / Cameron Road to a two-lane roundabout on the Great Ocean Road with pedestrian operated signals approximately 90 metres east of this intersection.

Output

- Upgrade existing roundabout to a two-lane roundabout
- Pedestrian operating signals
- Improved street lighting

Cost & Duration

- The project was completed on budget.
- The project was completed on time
