

Work is starting on the upgrade of the Carrum Downs to Seaford cycling and walking path

We're building a safer and more convenient place to ride and walk, for the local communities of Carrum Downs and Seaford.



Building a better path

The Victorian Government has invested \$1.5 million to upgrade the 5.6km Carrum Downs to Seaford cycling and walking path.

Once completed, the upgrade will provide a continuous path, safer crossings with new lighting, new signage and easier access to parks, shops, and transport.

The upgrade involves improvements from Lyrebird Drive in Carrum Downs to McKenzie Street, Seaford.

Key improvements

Lyrebird Drive

- Improved safety for cyclists and pedestrians with a new, clearly marked raised crossing
- Improved safety for all, by moving the east-side bus stop 20 m away from the new raised crossing
- Improved visibility for all road users with new lighting at the crossing

Botany Park

- Improved safety by removing the sharp bend in the path

Shearwater Reserve

- An easier ride on a new concrete path
- Improved visibility for all road users with new lighting at the Shearwater Drive crossing

Maple Street

- Improved safety with an upgrade of the existing crossing
- Improved safety with new green bike path markings on the approach to Maple Street.

Greaves Court/Old Wells Road

- Safer speeds with a new speed hump near the Greaves Court and Peninsula Link Trail crossing point.

McKenzie Street

- Smoother and easier ride on a new concrete path
- Improved access to the wetlands; replacement of the gate with removable bollards.

When are works starting?

Crews will be starting work in mid-July at Seaford and will work progressively towards Carrum Downs.

The path is expected to be ready for the community to enjoy in December.

Crews will be working 9.00am - 5.00pm, Monday to Friday.

At times, we may need to divert pedestrians and cyclists around the work zone. We will always ensure there is a safe and clearly marked route available.
