

Warrandyte Bridge Upgrade

We're upgrading Warrandyte Bridge to improve daily traffic flow and make it safer for the community.

What we're doing

We're upgrading the Warrandyte Bridge with VEC Civil Engineering Pty Ltd.

What's happening now?

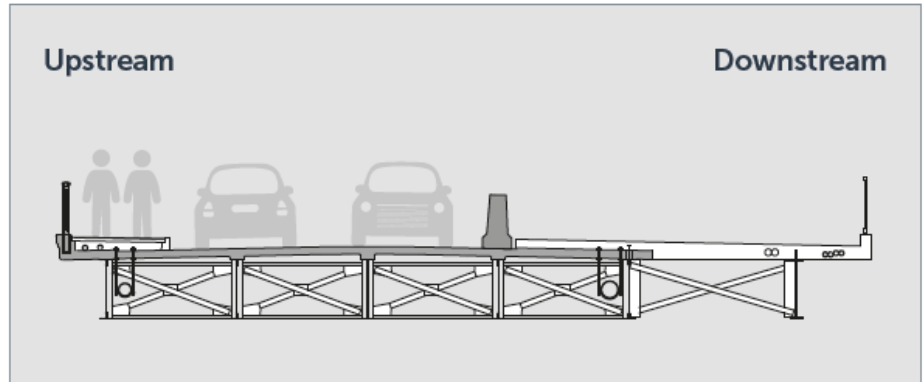
Additional bridge beams have been installed, so in June we'll continue working on the widened section of the bridge. These works include:

- road widening on the downstream side of the bridge
- Installing hand-railing on the downstream side of the bridge
- Strengthening work on north-eastern bridge beams
- complete footpath on northern side of bridge
- start works on Research-Warrandyte Road intersection.

When we're working

Concrete Pouring

We'll be pouring concrete on the downstream side of the bridge on Friday 15 June.

Traffic Switch

In late June, works will move to the centre of the bridge as stage 2 of construction begins. To manage this works area, we'll redirect northbound traffic to the new downstream lane. Southbound traffic will continue using the same lane. We'll have an overnight lane closure to complete this switch.

Other works

Further day works will generally run:

- Weekdays, 7am – 6pm
- Saturdays, 7am – 2.30pm

During day works, both lanes of the bridge will be open to traffic flow under traffic management.

Some works will be outside these times, to keep work crews safe and minimise our impact on traffic.

What to be aware of

The pedestrian footpath on the downstream side of the bridge will be closed until the second half of 2018. Pedestrian access will be maintained on the upstream side of the bridge.

For safety, there's a new 40km speed limit around the works area, and a new temporary pedestrian crossing between the bridge and the intersection of Kangaroo Ground-Warrandyte Road and Research-Warrandyte Road. This crossing will stay until works are completed.

Community Safety

We're outside of the peak bushfire season, but will continue working closely with emergency services and local councils. **For real-time warnings on fire risks in your area visit cfa.vic.gov.au**
