


Warrandyte Bridge Upgrade

We're upgrading Warrandyte Bridge to improve daily traffic flow and make it safer for the community.



Stage 3 of construction

What we're doing

We're upgrading the Warrandyte Bridge with VEC Civil Engineering Pty Ltd.

What's happening now?

Works will continue throughout August as we move into Stage 3 of construction. This will include:

- widening the existing footpath on the upstream side of the bridge
- continue installing pedestrian railing on the widened section of the bridge
- reinforcing the bridge deck to prepare for concrete pour
- drainage works
- constructing new kerbs and asphalt on both ends of the bridge
- continue service relocations of water and telecommunications
- prepare for the installation of new signals at the corner of Research-Warrandyte and Kangaroo Ground – Warrandyte Roads

When we're working

Traffic Switch

This month, works will move to the upstream side of the bridge, and we'll

redirect traffic to the new downstream lane. During this switch to Stage 3, pedestrian access will also be switched to the downstream side of the bridge. We'll have an overnight lane closure with contraflow and traffic management arrangements to complete this switch.

We may also need to close one lane of the bridge to complete some of the service relocation works. We'll notify the community once these works are confirmed.

Other works

Further day works will generally run:

- Weekdays, 7am – 6pm
- Saturdays, 7am – 2.30pm

During day works, both lanes of the bridge will be open to traffic flow under traffic management.

Some works will be outside these times, to keep work crews safe and minimise our impact on traffic.

What to be aware of

There are ongoing service relocation works, which may result in service disruptions. Your service provider will let you know if you'll be affected by this.

The pedestrian footpath on the downstream side of the bridge will be reopened during August. The pedestrian footpath on the upstream side of the bridge will be reopened after Stage 3 of construction is complete.

For safety, there's a 40km/h speed limit around the works area, and a new temporary pedestrian crossing between the bridge and the intersection of Kangaroo Ground-Warrandyte Road and Research-Warrandyte Road. This crossing will stay until works are completed.

Community Safety

We're continuing to work closely with emergency services and local councils throughout this project.
