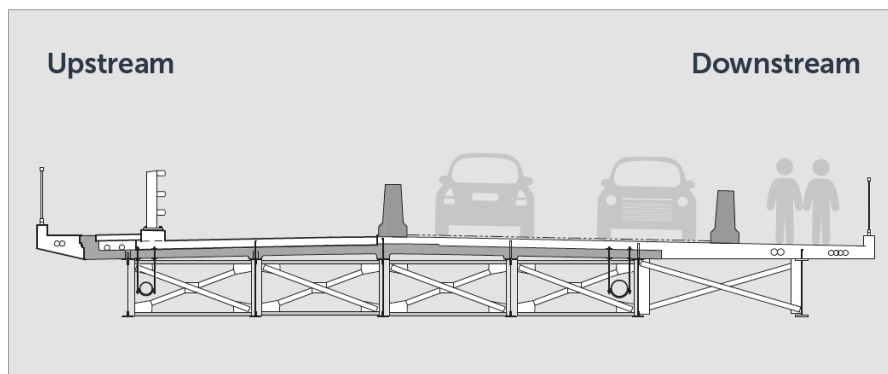


## Warrandyte Bridge Upgrade



### Stage 3 of construction

- strengthening under the bridge
- removing scaffolding, temporary crash barriers and construction facilities from site compound
- landscaping.

### What we're doing

We're upgrading the Warrandyte Bridge with VEC Civil Engineering Pty Ltd.

Works on Warrandyte Bridge began in late January 2018. Since then we've built the retaining walls, strengthened bridge beams, widened the abutments and bridge deck, relocated water and telecommunication services and high voltage electricity lines.

### What's happening now?

Works will continue throughout November and December, including:

- installing pedestrian railing
- upgrading the bus stop in Yarra Street
- completing the shared user paths
- installing public lighting, permanent crash barriers and guard rails
- installing traffic lights at the intersection of Research-Warrandyte Road and Kangaroo Ground-Warrandyte Road
- completing asphaltting and line marking
- installing signage

### Yarra Street bus stop upgrade

We're working with Public Transport Victoria (PTV) to upgrade the bus stop at the Warrandyte Bridge Bus Terminal. This bus stop upgrade will accommodate articulated (bendy) buses, improve service reliability and help you get to where you need to go sooner.

This work is being delivered at the same time as the Warrandyte Bridge Upgrade to minimise construction impacts on the community and is expected to be completed in mid-December.

During the work, the bus stop at the terminal will be closed for safety. You will be able to use the bus stop located 270m west of the bridge, near the shops. We thank you for your patience during these crucial works.

### When we're working

Day works will generally run:

- Weekdays, 7am – 6pm
- Saturdays, 7am – 2.30pm

During day works, both lanes of the bridge will remain open with traffic management.

Some works will be outside these times to keep our work crew safe and minimise traffic impacts.

### What to be aware of

#### Asphaltting works

Soon we will be completing asphaltting works on the bridge and surrounding roads with assistance from traffic management. We'll provide more information in the coming weeks once dates/times are confirmed.

#### Pedestrian footpath access

During the traffic switch, pedestrian access was moved to the downstream side of the bridge.

For safety, there's a 40km/h speed limit around the work area and a temporary pedestrian crossing between the bridge and the intersection of Kangaroo Ground-Warrandyte Road and Research-Warrandyte Road. This crossing will remain until works are complete.

### **Bus stop works**

During the bus stop upgrade, there will be ground works to create the foundations for the new bus stop. Construction machinery will move in and out of the site with assistance from traffic management to enable the work and to remove excavated materials.

Occasional lane closures may be needed on Yarra Street during these works.

There will also be periods where the stairs will be closed to ensure works can be done safely. During these times pedestrian access will be clearly signed.

### **Community Safety**

We're continuing to work closely with emergency services and council, and have a comprehensive emergency management plan in place.
