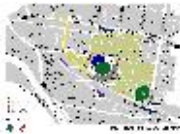

Hello All,

Please find set out below, details of Operation Cadence this weekend.

Overview

- Operation Cadence is the code name for the security and transport arrangements around this weekends VIP visitor to Melbourne.
- The Operation will managed from the Special Police Operations Centre (SPOC), 29A(1)(a)
- Operation Cadence includes 8 planned motorcade movements over 3 days - I am advised there will be 42 vehicles in the VIP motorcade.
- VicRoads TMC is assisting Police through the provision of a traffic signal "green wave" for the motorcade.
- VicRoads is also providing a Liaison Officer in the SPOC between 6.00pm Saturday 16 July 2016 and 1.00pm Monday 18 July 2016.
- There is a planned protest march (Black Lives Matter) on Sunday 17 July 2016 at 12:45pm - route and other details unknown at this time.

Roles

- The VicRoads Liaison Officers role is to:
 - Attend the SPOC - access is via the front reception and the contact is 33(1) 33(1) (you will be escorted into the SPOC)
 - Represent VicRoads at the Police briefings
 - Pro-actively participate in discussions as required
 - Maintain awareness of any unplanned lane and road closures, including accidents, utility works and protest actions
 - Provide advice to Police regarding any traffic or road conditions that may affect the Operation
 - Provide advice to the TMC on any issues or changes to the transport routes
 - Escalate any issues that remain unresolved by the expected resolution time
 - Provide a brief summary at the end of each shift (via text message to the other Liaisons and Escalation Contacts)
- The TMC's role is to:
 - Activate and manage the traffic signal green wave for all the planned motorcade movements (as provided by Police)
 - Maintain awareness of any unplanned lane and road closures, including accidents, utility works and protest actions

- Provide advice to the VicRoads Liaison Officer in the SPOC on any issues that may affect the Operation
- Respond to relevant requests from the VicRoads Liaison Officer at the SPOC
- Escalate any issues that remain unresolved by the expected resolution time

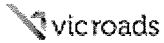
