World Day for Safety and Health at Work and Workers Memorial Day 28.04.16



Australia's work-related fatality rates have been steadily trending downwards over recent years, although sadly, in 2015, 193 workers tragically lost their lives at work. The majority of these were related to the construction, forestry, and transport industries.

On Thursday 28 April 2016 we recognise ***World Day for Safety and Health at Work and Workers' Memorial Day*** – a day to think about how our actions can prevent future work-related deaths, injuries, illnesses and diseases, and a day to remember those that have died from a work-related injury or illness.

By raising awareness of the importance of work health and safety and taking collaborative proactive action to control workplace hazards and associated risks by focusing on the implementation of 'higher order risk control measures' (**'Working Above The Line'**) such as elimination, substitution, isolation, engineering etc, we can actively help prevent further injuries and death.

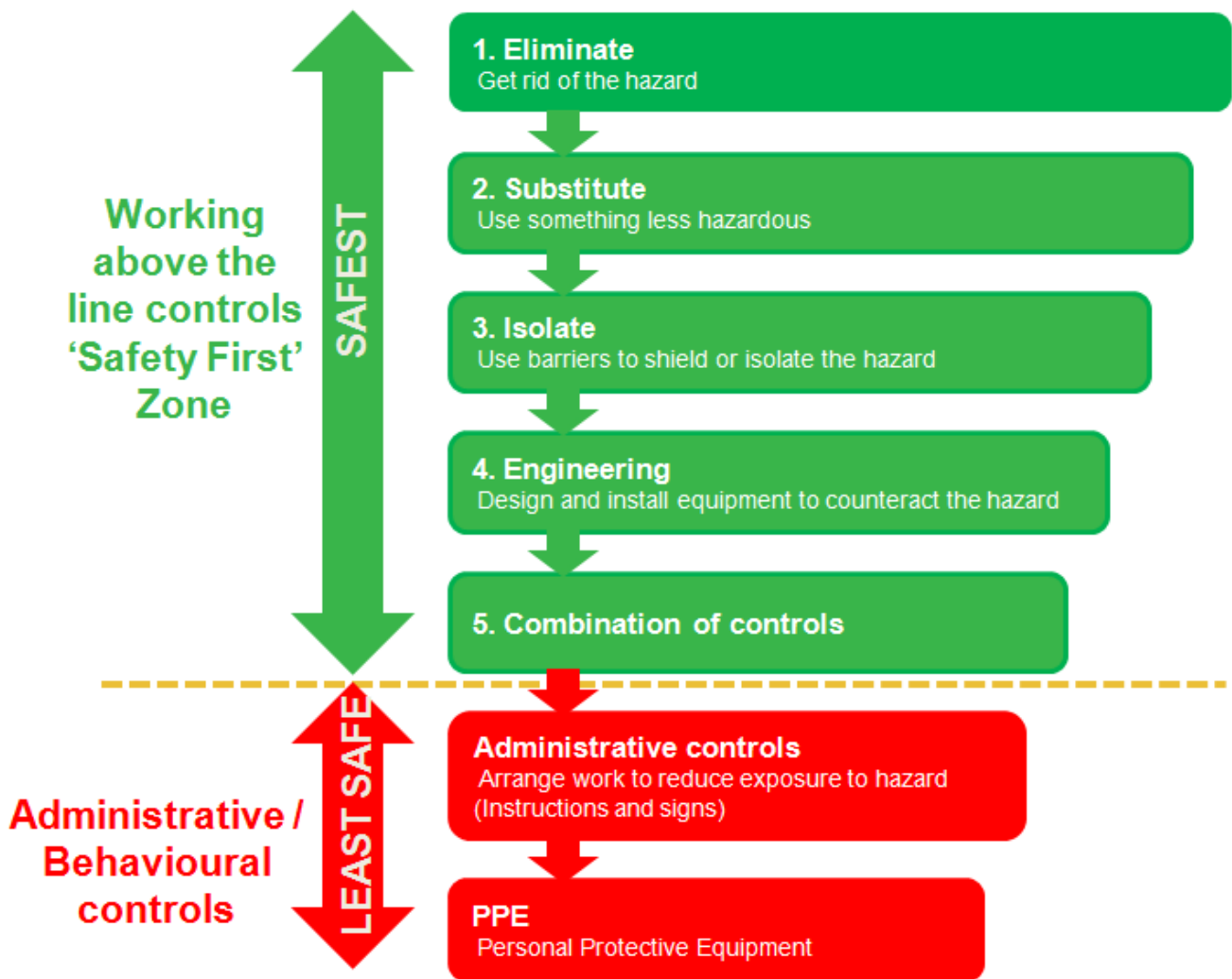
