

Application to drive a Lower Performance Turbocharged /Supercharged Vehicle manufactured prior to 1 January 2010

(FEE APPLIES)

Road Safety (Drivers) Regulations 2009 – regulation 5 and Road Safety (Drivers) Amendment (Probationary Prohibited Vehicles) Regulations 2014

This form is to be used by a learner and/or probationary driver to apply for permission to drive some lowerperformance turbocharged or supercharged cars with greater fuel-efficiency that were manufactured* prior to 1 January 2010.

* Date of manufacture is the date shown on the vehicle's compliance plate, or where the vehicle has been imported in used condition, the 'Built' or 'Built Date' recorded on a metal plate or a component of the vehicle.

Permission may be granted for vehicles that meet the criteria below. A VicRoads exemption must be approved before driving the vehicle.

Lower performance vehicles that can be considered;

- turbocharged or supercharged with a power to weight ratio of less than 100kW per tonne;
- turbocharged or supercharged with a power to weight ratio between 100kW and 125kW per tonne and that are considered to be a family type vehicle (4 or more seats) rather than a sports type vehicle.

What is a family type vehicle?

A family type vehicle is typically a sedan, station wagon or hatch used to carry families with 4 or more seats and when manufactured was equipped with child restraint anchorages. A family type vehicle does not include sports cars (eg; two door coupe) or the sports oriented variant of a specific model range.

Vehicles that are **not** considered to meet the above criteria include:

- vehicles that has 8 cylinders or more
- vehicles which has been modified to increase vehicle's performance, other than a modification made by the manufacture of the vehicle
- vehicles which has a high performance 6 cylinder engine (naturally aspirated)
- power to weight ratio above 100kW/tonne please review VicRoads website to check status of vehicle (ie: Exemption Application Required or Banned vehicle)
- vehicles designed and marketed as sports variant
- used imported vehicle where data does not exist for this vehicle.

Please access the VicRoads website, <u>www.vicroads.vic.gov.au</u>, to check if your vehicle is approved, exemption is required, or banned. If your vehicle is a banned vehicle, please complete and submit the VicRoads Probationary Prohibited Vehicle Exemption Application form which can be found on the VicRoads website.

VicRoads may request you to provide further information on the vehicle if it is not listed on the probationary prohibited vehicle database. This information will need to come from a creditable and reliable source eg. vehicle manufacturer.

You can also search 'Lower performance supercharged or turbocharged exemption' for more information about the process, requirements and fees to apply for this exemption.

Submit application

You need to download this form and fill in the correct sections.

The form will need to be uploaded to vicroads.vic.gov.au, along with the supporting documentation to support your exemption application.

You will have to pay a fee when you submit your document.

Once the application is submitted, you will receive a confirmation email from VicRoads.

Outcome of the application

You will be contacted within 15 working days of submitting your application.

If you have not been contacted you can call 13 11 71 with your driver licence number and the exemption application number for more information.

There are no reviews or refunds of rejected exemption applications.

If your driver licence is cancelled or suspended, any exemption may be withdrawn. This will have an impact on your licence when it is reissued or the suspension ends. If we decide to withdraw the exemption, you will be notified in writing and given an opportunity to show why you should be permitted to retain the exemption. If you don't respond to the notice within the required time, the exemption will be withdrawn without further notice.

NOTE: The personal information that you provide on this form will be used by VicRoads to assess your application for an exemption under regulation 57(4)(a), 57(4)(b) of the Road Safety (Drivers) Regulations 2009. Failure to provide the information may result in your application not being processed.

The personal information we collect from you in association with your application may be used only in accordance with the Road Safety Act 1986 and associated Regulations or as otherwise required by law. Your personal information may be disclosed to contractors and agents of VicRoads, law enforcement agencies or Courts authorised to collect it.
