Confirmation of vehicle safety

On the initial issue of a Rally Permit, the following items are required:

- Proof of a log book for the vehicle from an approved motor sport organisation; and either
- A current Certificate of Roadworthiness (RWC) issued in Victoria, or
- A Scrutineers Form completed, in the 30 days prior to this application, by an authorised officer of an approved motor sport organisation.

Conditions of permit issue

1) A Rally Permit is a 12 month Unregistered Vehicle Permit (UVP) which allows the use of a vehicle for the following purposes:

- During approved rallies conducted by a club affiliated with a national motorsport organisation approved by VicRoads; or
 - In associated 'transport or liaison stages'* of an approved rally; or
 - Travelling to and from an approved rally; or
 - Travelling to and from scrutineering of an approved rally; or
 - In testing the vehicle for an approved rally (letter from CAMS permitting testing is required); or
 - In conducting official duties (e.g. course cars) of an approved rally (letter from CAMS permitting use is required); or
 - For travelling locally to and from general vehicle repairer; or
 - For travelling to and from specialised repairer.
- * 'Transport or liaison stages' is defined as non-competitive section of an event that connect the competitive sections, start, finish and any service parks on the route of the event.

2) The operator of the vehicle must be the holder of:

- A current National Rally Licence (or a higher level competition licence), or
- A current International Rally Licence, or
- An alternative competition licence approved by VicRoads.

3) A log book of a type approved by VicRoads must be maintained and carried in the vehicle when in use. (CAMS logbooks are the only approved type.)

4) The permit is not transferable.
