

How to apply for a new Accident Tow Truck Driver Accreditation/ Renewal of Accident Tow Truck Driver Accreditation

To be able to drive an accident tow truck, you must be accredited.

To be accredited, you must apply to VicRoads. VicRoads will assess your application in accordance with the *Accident Towing Services Act 2007* and *Accident Towing Services Regulations 2008*.

VicRoads has 30 days to assess your application. If additional information is required, this period may be extended. VicRoads will advise you in writing if this is the case.

To apply for accreditation or to renew your accreditation, you must submit the following documents to VicRoads in support of your application.

Application Form

Complete and sign the Accident Tow Truck Driver Accreditation Form, making sure to tick for 'New Accreditation' or 'Renewal of Accreditation'. Please complete every question on the form thoroughly. This will help VicRoads to assess your application and process it more quickly.

Passport Photos and Proof of Identification

To enable VicRoads to process your application, two passport-sized photographs of you, and a copy of your driver's licence are required. The passport-sized photographs must be:

- no more than six months old, dated and signed by the photographer; and
- on a plain, light coloured background; and
- an acceptable likeness to you; and
- a full front view of your head and shoulders, without any head covering or tinted glasses. If you normally wear prescription glasses, you should wear them for your photograph.

VicRoads will only accept a photograph that shows all your facial features.

A copy of your driver's licence is required as proof of identification.

Application Fee

A fee is payable to VicRoads by cheque or money order. This fee is for processing your application. If you are successful you will be issued with an Accident Tow Truck accreditation certificate for up to three years. You can find out the current fee by going to the Tow Truck section of the VicRoads webpage and clicking on Fees, or by telephoning VicRoads on (03) 9881 8787. If VicRoads refuses your application, the application fee and any documentation that you have supplied to VicRoads will be returned to you.

National Police Certificate

A current National Police Certificate issued within the last six months is required. You can go to the Victoria Police website police.vic.gov.au to order the National Police Certificate. It may take up to ten working days to obtain a Certificate, and the Certificate must be sent to VicRoads with your application.

Privacy Statement

VicRoads is committed to protecting your privacy by fully meeting its responsibilities under the *Road Safety Act 1986*, *Privacy and Data Protection Act 2014* and the *Health Records Act 2001*. All personal information you provide will be handled in accordance with these requirements. The collection of information on this form is required by the *Accident Towing Services Act 2007*. Information held by VicRoads may be disclosed to various organisations, including the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal and Victoria Police, in order to carry out their duties under the *Accident Towing Services Act 2007*.

- The application fee is accepted on a conditional basis. Acceptance of payment does not mean that VicRoads has approved the application.
- If VicRoads refuses your application, the application fee and any documentation that you have supplied to VicRoads will be returned to you.
